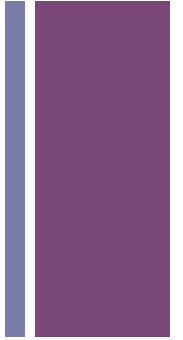

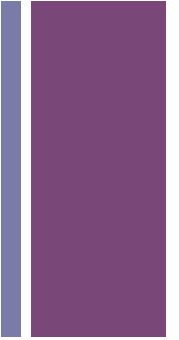

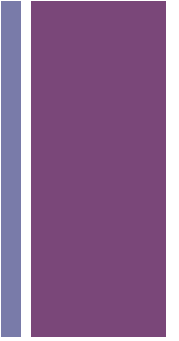
+ What does it mean by sacrifice of life?

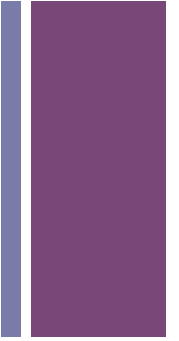
- Spiritual
