The rights we owe to our fellow human beings

Description:

In light of the Islamic teachings of fulfilling the rights of our fellow beings, secretaries are asked to organise an informal meet up of the youth and the Lajna with the elderly member of the local majlis. This can either be fulfilled by arranging and inviting the elderly to a 'chit chat and chai' or by visiting them in their home. Special focus should be given to the elderly in the majlis who live alone and not in a joint family.

However, this should not be limited to looking after the welfare of the elderly, secretaries should explain to Lajna who else Allah has commanded upon us to look after.

How can the responsibility Haqooq-ul-Ibaad be fulfilled ?

Secretary Khidmat-e-Khalq should strive to become a role model of these beautiful teachings of Islam herself first, and then encourage the local Lajna to follow these teachings too.

Everyone should make great efforts to inculcate the habit of fulfilling the 'duties towards mankind' within our homes and outside, so wherever Ahmadi Muslims live, they become a source of comfort for all those around them and the society.

After fulfilling the rights of parents and kinship (blood relations), Lajna members should focus on fulfilling the rights of :

- Orphans
- Needy (Elderly, disabled, vulnerable members of the society, weak, widows
- etc)
- Neighbours (near and far)
- Colleagues at college/work etc
- Someone who is a traveller 'Musaffir', guests
- Employee/ subordinate

Wherever possible, local Lajna should implement these within their local majlis first and then extend service outside.

Allah the Almighty says in the Holy Quran:

'And worship Allah and associate naught with Him, and show kindness to parents, and to kindred, and orphans, and the needy, and to the neighbour that is a kinsman and the neighbour that is a stranger, and the companion by your side, and the wayfarer, and those whom your right hands possess. Surely, Allah loves not the proud and the boastful

In this verse, Allah the Almighty commands not only to treat your brothers, your near ones, your relatives, your acquaintances, and your neighbours kindly, but also be compassionate to them, help them if they are in need, and be beneficent to the best of your ability to even those people whom you do not know and have no relationship or association with. And be beneficent to those whom you have only met temporarily. If they are in need of your sympathy or your help and can benefit from you, then you must help them. By doing so, a beautiful culture of Islam will be established. Develop compassion for God's creatures, with the understanding that it is something more than a good deed, it falls into the category of benevolence. Benevolence means not expecting the return of your favours; benevolence is exercised by man purely for the sake of Allah the Almighty. In this way, such a beautiful society will be established where there will be no dispute between husband and wife, mother-in-law and daughter-in-law, brothers, and neighbors. Everyone will try to be benevolent to the other. Each person will try to give others their rights with love and care, and will do so purely to win the love of Allah. In today's society, this is even more urgent than ever before. Allah says that if you do not follow this path, then you will be counted as arrogant. And Allah does not like arrogance.

Supporting Shelters

Description:

To fulfil this month's target, Secretaries should research how many shelters (women, teenage, refugee etc) in their local community. This information can be found by approaching local council, charities and online search portal.

To support the local shelter, Secretaries should contact the organisation and ask them what support she can provide. The support can be in the form of physical/ monetary donations or volunteering.

Secretaries can work in partnership with the **Secretary Trade & Handicraft**, who can assist in providing hand-made items for donations under the '**From Lajna with Love**' campaign. Secretary Khidmat-e-Khalq can reach out to shelters and ask what items they require, e.g. Baby blankets, knitted baby clothes, gloves, scarves, hand made baby toys etc. Then once the need has been identified, the Secretary Trade & Handicraft can assist in getting the items made from Lajna and then these can be donated to this cause.

During this period the bounty of the Holy Prophet waxed faster than the rain-bearing breeze.

Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (may Allah be his helper) said:

“When fasting is based on taqwa (righteousness) it produces a beautiful society, creating a spirit of sacrifice for each other. One is drawn to the ..

..needs of one's under-privileged brothers and this is very important because it was the blessed model of the Holy Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) that during Ramadan his alms-giving and charity would gain intense momentum like a gale storm.

This becomes a source of removing anxiety from society and creates feelings of empathy for the less fortunate among those who are well-off; and feelings of love and gratefulness in the hearts of under-privileged believers for their well-off brothers."
