1. STUDY OF THE HOLY QURAN - TA'LIM WORKSHOP

1. What is the meaning of the word At-Tariq?
2. According to the commentary, to whom do verses 2, 3 and 4 of this Surah refer to?
3. What is the meaning of verse 5, "There is no soul but has a guardian over it"?

2. COMMANDMENT OF THE HOLY QURAN - GENERAL MEETING

In Surah Al Baqarah, Verse 255 of the Holy Quran, Allah Taala commands the believers to:

This important Commandment of Allah Taala draws the attention of believers towards spending in the way of Allah with the intention to solely win the Pleasure of Allah Taala. The verse further emphasises how a believer must always remember that every provision that he or she has been granted has been given by Allah Taala. It also reflects on the importance of giving to charity, and to those in need and the importance of gratitude and trust in Allah Taala at all times, as our sole Provider.

3. ATTRIBUTE OF ALLAH ALMIGHTY - GENERAL MEETING

This month, let us reflect on the Attribute of **As-Sattar**, The One who covers weaknesses and failings.

In his Friday Sermon of 3rd April 2009, Beloved Huzur (aba) explained that the word Sattar connotes to cover and protect something. Our Loving God forgives our countless mistakes and does not punish us for our shortcomings instantly. True believers are those who benefit from this kindness by becoming aware of their failings and try to reform rather than get more audacious. When God covers the failings of man then man should also pay attention to his lapses and come in the sphere of God's refuge and experience wondrous manifestations of the Divine quality of being Sattar.

ACTIVITY: In your meeting this month, reflect on how we can adopt this attribute of Allah Taala within ourselves and strive to cover the faults and weakness of others so that Allah Taala covers our own weaknesses and shortcomings. How does one adopt such qualities and what are the means to achieve this?

As we continue our study of this book, this month we focus on the duties imposed by Islam on a State.

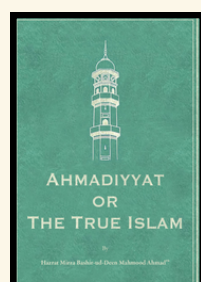
ACTIVITY: Questions to consider as part of self-study/group discussion:
