History

- On Friday 9th July 1957, in a passionate Sermon of Eid-ul-Adha, Hazrat Khalifatul Masih II (ra) outlined the blessed Scheme of Waqf-e-Jadid (The New Dedication).

- The Scheme was announced on Friday, 27th December 1957.

- and Sahibzada Mirza Tahir Ahmad Sahib (who would later become Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (ra) was appointed as the first Director (Nazim Irshad) of Waqfe Jadid.

- In 1985, Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih IV (ra) broadened the scope of Waqf-e-Jadid and now all the countries of the world are covered by the Scheme

Objectives

- There were 2 objectives laid out by Hazrat Musleh Maud (ra):
 1. Create a network of Mu'alimeen (religious teachers) who should be wholly devoted to the upbringing of the members throughout Pakistan.
 2. Bring the message of Islam to the Hindu population of Pakistan

“Now is not the time that one murabbi should be going around the whole state visiting from place to place spending an hour here and an hour there. NO!..Now the time has come that our murabbi will have to reach every home and hut and this can only happen when you act upon my Scheme, and from one end of the country to the other, in every place, such people should be appointed who should live among the people of that area and who, by their pious example, should impress the people of their assigned area and should teach them also and should carry out also the works of reformation and training...” [Alfazal, January 11, 1985]

Purpose

- Waqfe Jadid has expanded greatly and shows some amazing examples of financial giving. This scheme was initiated to support Tarbiyyat and Tabligh efforts in rural and far-off areas of Pakistan but was later extended to the rest of the world.
- It still has specific objectives and certain areas/regions are designated to benefit from it. As such only specific countries and regions are funded by contributions raised by Waqfe Jadid.
- Generally it is African countries and rural areas in India where Waqf-e-Jadid is funding many projects.

Importance

Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih II (ra), explaining the importance of this blessed Scheme, stated “This is the work of God, and it shall certainly be completed. As God has placed this zeal in my heart, I am going to perform this duty even if I have to sell my houses, my clothes. Even if not a single person assists me, God will remove all those who are not helping me and shall cause angels to descend from heavens to lend me support. So, to rest my case, once again I make this call so that people may consider taking part in financial offerings as well as devoting themselves.” (Al-Fazal, January 5, 1962)



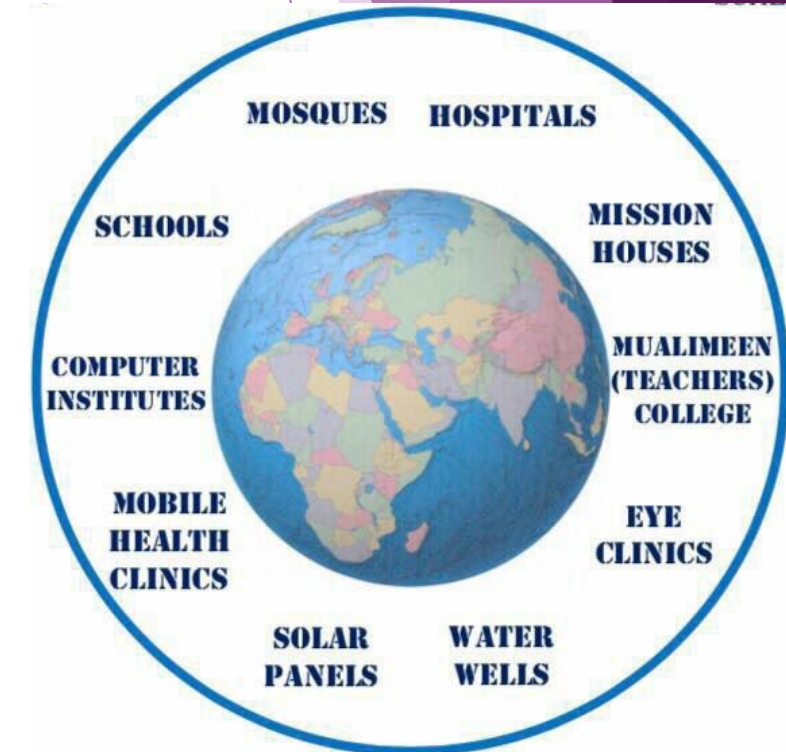

How Are The Collections Spent?

- ▶ A third of the contributions received by Waqf-e-Jadid is spent in the countries where it is collected.
- ▶ One portion of the remaining two is spent in Qadian and the rest of India.
- ▶ The remainder in African and some other countries.

How Do Your Contributions Help?

- ▶ **£750** will send a Mu'allim (Teacher) to a village for 1 year
- ▶ **£1000** will maintain a mosque in India or Pakistan for a year
- ▶ **£1200** will train Muslim (teacher) 4 year course
- ▶ **£3000** will build a make-shift mosque in Africa
- ▶ **£7,200** will help to build a mosque in a village in India or Pakistan

Targets

- Do encourage every lajna, nasirat, and children under seven to participate in **their own name and get a receipt**, even if pledge is very small.
- Get a **Jama'at receipt book** from Jama'at President so you can give receipts, and send collected money to Jama'at Waqfe Jadid secretary.
- Remind sisters frequently to pay pledges **throughout year** to avoid rush at the end of year.
