Waqf-e-Jadid (The New Dedication)

This is the last month of the Waqf-e-Jadid financial year and last opportunity to gain the blessings of contributing toward the Waqf-e-Jadid Scheme.

What is the Waqf-e-Jadid Scheme?

Waqf-e-Jadid (the new dedication) was launched to spread Islam and Ahmadiyyat in the remote areas of Pakistan, especially in the province of Sindh. Hazrat Khalifatul Masih II (ra) called for funds, as well as men with sound religious knowledge to volunteer their time for this noble cause.

As years passed, the number of volunteers increased, and then a proper training system was established. Initially, this scheme was launched to fulfil the needs of remote areas in Pakistan. Gradually, this was expanded to Africa and India.

After migrating to the UK, in 1985 Hazrat Khalifa-tul-Masih IV (rh) made this scheme worldwide.

I am a bit confused as to why Sunni Muslims do not accept Ahmadis as Muslims when we have the same belief in Allah and the Prophet Muhammad (saw). Why is it so, especially in Pakistan when Ahmadis have been declared non-Muslims?

· Ahmadis Muslims believe that the Holy Prophet (sa) is the Seal of Prophets and is the final law-bearing prophet. Then, according to the prophecies made by the Holy Prophet (sa) himself, his Mesiab, and the spiritual second coming of Jesus (as) would manifest in the latter days. In fulfillment of these prophecies, Ahmadis believe Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as) of Qadian (1835-1908) to be the same prophesied Messiah and reformer. Ahmadis believe that Jesus (as) died a natural death and that he was to return spiritually, not physically. Ahmadis also believe Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as) to be a subordinate prophet to the Holy Prophet (sa), and that this rank was afforded to him only because of being in complete obedience and submission to the Holy Prophet (sa).

· Non-Ahmadis believe that by holding this belief, Ahmadis dishonour (God forbid) the status of the Holy Prophet (sa) as the seal of prophets. This however is not the case at all. There is no person or prophet who ranks higher in the sight of Ahmadi Muslims than the Holy Prophet (sa), and the Promised Messiah (as) was his ardent devotee. For example, the Promised Messiah (as) said: "Had I not been a follower of the Holy Prophet, peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, and had not obeyed him, then even if my good deeds had reached the tops of mountains, I would not have been honoured with the converse of God inasmuch as all prophethoods except the Muhammadi prophethood have come to an end." (Tajalliat Ilahiyah, p. 24)

· Hence, much of the persecution faced by Ahmadis is due to a lack of understanding and misinformation. A great deal of this misinformation can be attributed to clerics, who incite the Muslims masses against Ahmadis.

· On one occasion, His Holiness, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad (aba) said: "It is the leaders of the disbelievers, who have incited the innocent Muslims [against Ahmadis] by spreading false information. The general [Muslim] population, perhaps owing to their lack of knowledge, believe that Ahmadis, God-forbid, dishonour the Holy Prophetsa and therefore hold the view that such treatment should be meted out against Ahmadis because whatever the maulvi has said must be true. This is the condition of the general Muslims; however, those maulvis who actually possess knowledge, know full well whatever they say has no basis whatsoever and they simply wish to create disorder, so that they may remain in service at their pulpits, and no one may remove them."
