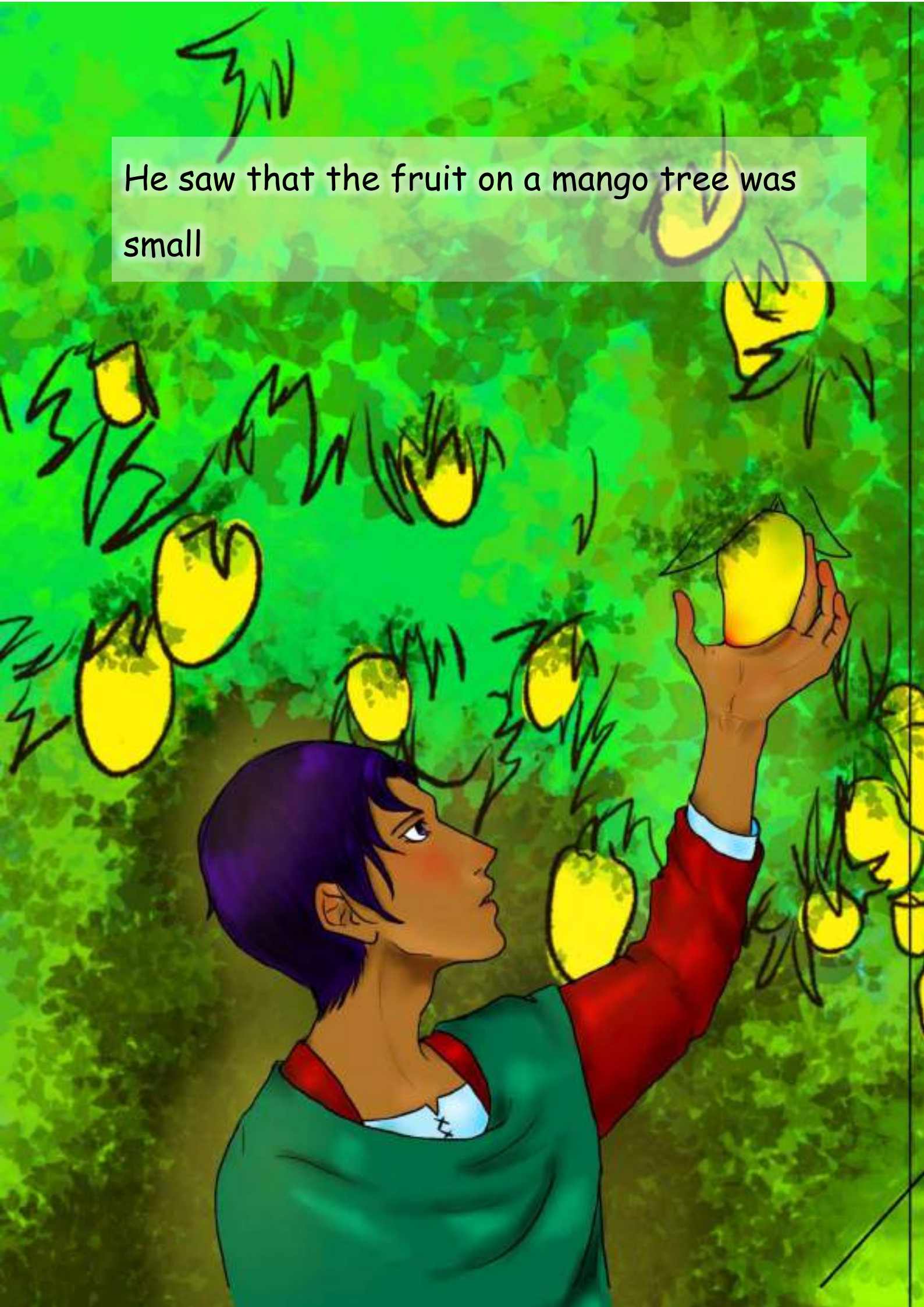



A well known story tells that

Later, he lay down to take a restful nap under the same mango tree.

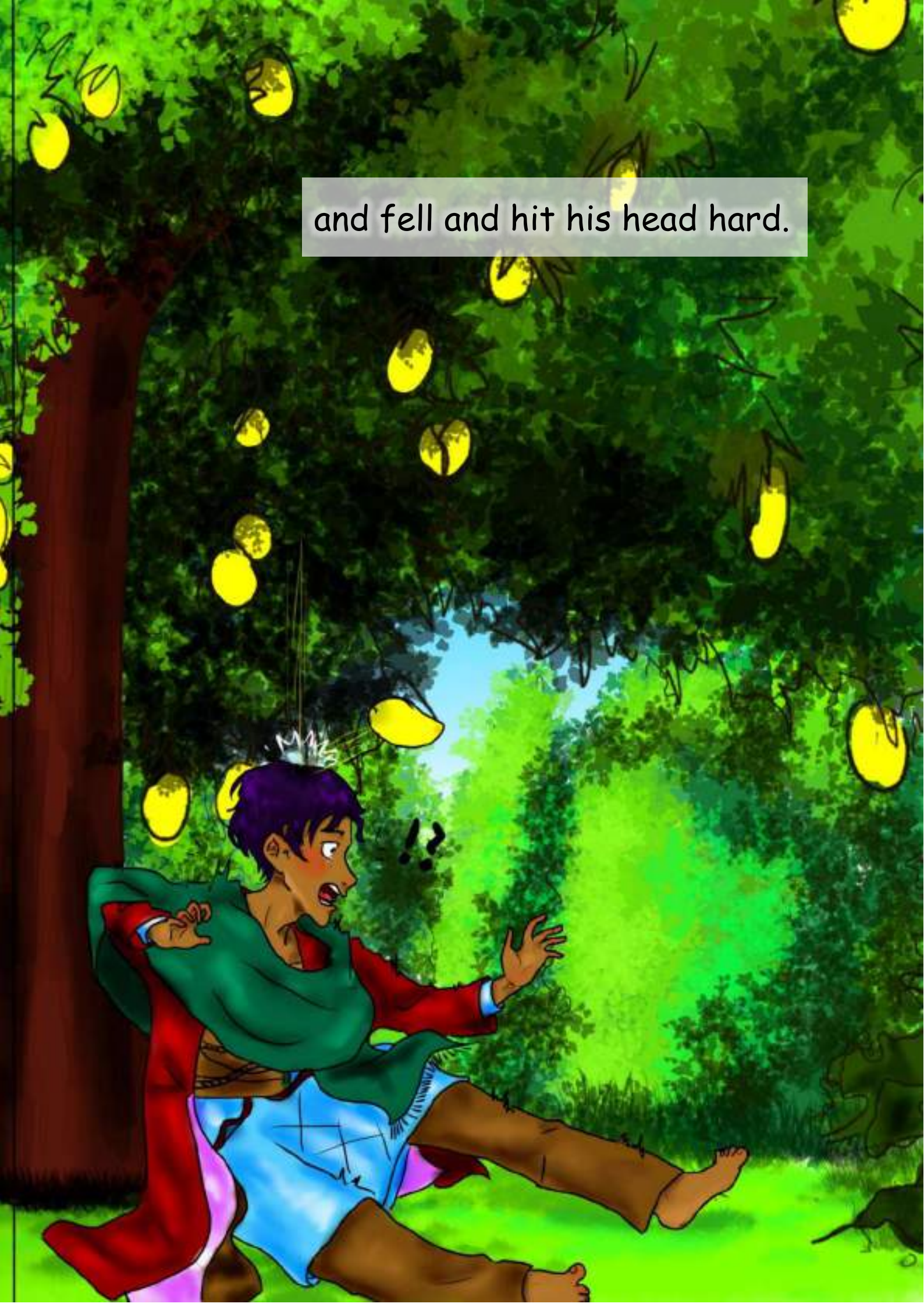






He was asleep when suddenly a mango broke from the tree
