RELIGIOUS & MORAL TRAINING

“Allah the Almighty has said that the moral training of a child should start from birth. Hence, the Holy Prophet of Islam (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) taught that when a Muslim child is born the Adhan and Iqamah (calls to prayer) should be recited to the child so that Allah’s name enters his ear from birth. Thus, the moral training of a child starts on day one and so do not think that a young infant cannot understand anything.”

“As the child gets older, explain to him that whatever they have has been bestowed by Allah the Almighty and He has fulfilled all their needs and that they should express their gratitude to Him. When a child reaches the age of seven you should encourage them to do their prayers as much as possible, however at the same time, you should not put a young child under stress or cause them anxiety. Treat them with love and tenderness. The key point to remember is that the lessons a person learns in childhood are often those that last a lifetime.”





MOTHER AND DAUGHTER BOND

Hadrat Khalifatul Masih II (ra) advised the ladies of the Ahmadi Jama'at that if they wished to permanently instil great faith in their children, - a task even greater than the conquests of famous generals and kings, then they and they alone, were capable of doing so. This indeed was a great tribute to mothers and an acknowledgement of the magnitude of their work in the moral training of children. Elaborating on this huge responsibility, Hadrat Musleh Maud (ra) stated;

“...it is only women who can challenge Satan permanently. If women decide that they are going to make the future generations servants of religion then who will Satan corrupt? The future generation is not influenced by Satan but by their mothers, but mothers can make the mistake of letting them go so that they become the bait hunted by Satan.....You must understand your responsibilities.”

INFERIORITY COMPLEX

“Accepting the Messiah of this age is a blessing of Allah upon us. After accepting him, we should try to increase in our faith and openly give the message of Islam. Though most are active, some people think that we shouldn’t mention Islam too much because of the conditions of Muslims today. Huzoor said that we should become even bolder at this time because this condition of Muslims is according to the prophecy of the Holy Prophet (saw). At this time, the Messiah and Mahdi was to be sent to revive true Islam. Therefore, there shouldn’t be any inferiority complex. Some people have become too involved in worldliness in Western countries. We show good morals in society, but we are lacking in worship. We are lacking in mutual respect. The purpose of the Promised Messiah (as) wasn’t just to reform beliefs; it was also practical reform. As our message spreads, the world will keep a close eye on us. Therefore, we need practical reformation in us and remember the true purpose of Bai’at.

WOMEN'S RIGHTS

Huzoor (aba) said that generally, it is alleged that Islam does not grant freedom to women. However, this allegation is raised only due to a lack of knowledge, or simply for the sake of levelling an allegation. Islam teaches that if a peaceful society is sought, then everyone's rights must be given and everyone must play their role and duty. Islam does not merely tell women to obtain their rights, but also teaches them to understand their rank and to abstain from evil.

His Holiness^(aba) said that God has given various teachings regarding women, and the practical example of how to honour women was set perfectly by the Holy Prophet^(sa). Then, in this age, the Promised Messiah^(as) showed us how women should be honoured and respected, and these teachings have been reiterated by his successors. When all of these teachings are present, one should not think that Islam has not established the rights of women.

His Holiness^(aba) said that the right of women highlighted by Islam have not been mentioned in any other spiritual or worldly law. His Holiness^(aba) said that the rights given to women by Islam are also made clear through the verses of the Holy Qur'an that are recited at the time of *Nikah* (Islamic marriage announcement).

WOMEN'S RIGHTS

It is stated in the Holy Qur'an:

"He it is Who has created you from a single soul, and made therefrom its mate, that he might find comfort in her. And when he knows her, she bears a light burden, and goes about with it. And when she grows heavy, they both pray to Allah, their Lord, saying: "If Thou give us a good child, we will surely be of the thankful." (7:190)

Huzoor ^(aba) said that this shows, from the very outset of a marriage, it has been made clear that men and women are equal, and they have been created from a single soul, and thus both possess similar qualities.
