

Essential components of the course

1. Quranic Studies

This will include a detailed study of Surah Al-A'raf.

2. Hadith

The study of Hadith will include Hadith No 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35, with explanation from "Forty Gems of Beauty" by Hazrat Mirza Bashir Ahmad sahib^{ra}.

3. Books of the Promised Messiah^{as} and Malfuzat

The following book of the Promised Messiah^{as} and Malfuzat to be studied during the year:

- 1) Brahin e Ahmadiyya Part V For Urdu in Ruhani Khazain Volume 21
- 2) Malfuzat Volume 2 from: 6th January 1900 until end of 12th April 1900. For Urdu in Malfuzat Volume 1
- 3) Comparative study of Religions

With regards to comparative study of religions, candidates are required to research and submit a written paper on basic concepts, practises and beliefs of Sikhism compared with those of Islam.

This paper should include arguments and references from Jamaat literature. Length for paper should be between 2000 to 3000 words and must be submitted by the 31st July 2024.


