- 1. Protect our faith
- Act upon all the commands of Allah the Almighty
- Give precedence to our faith over all worldly matters and pleasures
- Make our life's purpose to attain the pleasure of Allah
- Love Allah the Almighty more than anyone or anything
- Strive to fulfill the rights of our neighbours
- Do not mock or taunt anyone
- Show our best manners and etiquettes in any public setting and in our home
- Desire for our sisters what we would desire for ourselves
- 10. Show complete obedience and respect to Nizaam-e-Jama'at
- 11. Never speak ill of any Jama'at office bearer- if we feel we have been wronged we take the correct route prescribed by Khalifatul Masih (aba)
- 12. Follow the etiquettes of the mosque and the etiquettes of Salat
- 13. If we attend Jama'at programs with the sincere intention of acting on all good things learned
- 14. Refrain from showing aggressive behaviour to anyone, in any setting. Instead we show patience and politeness to whomever we speak to
- 15. Closely monitor the content our children are watching on TV
- 16. Develop a purely Islamic atmosphere within our homes where the commands of Allah are acted upon and the best morals are displayed
- 17. Develop a loving and close bond with our children
- 18. Share pious examples and stories of righteous people in our homes
- 19. Refrain from any small act of lying
- 20. Maintain our dignity and tolerate any difficulty or pain patiently and keep our trust in Allah
- 21. Show humility and shun all forms of arrogance and pride. We do not allow our tongue to cause pain to anyone
- 22. Remember those in greater need than us and are regular in our sadqah and spending in the cause of Allah the Almighty
- 23. Safeguard our modesty, observe purdah and understand it is prescribed for both men and women
- 24. Are vigilant using social media platforms--refrain from sharing personal photos/videos & engaging in frivolous conversations or chats
- 25. Offer our prayers carefully and ponder over their meaning
- 26.Pray for ourselves, our husbands, our children, our society and Jama'at
- 27. Pray with the thought that we are submitting ourselves before Allah
