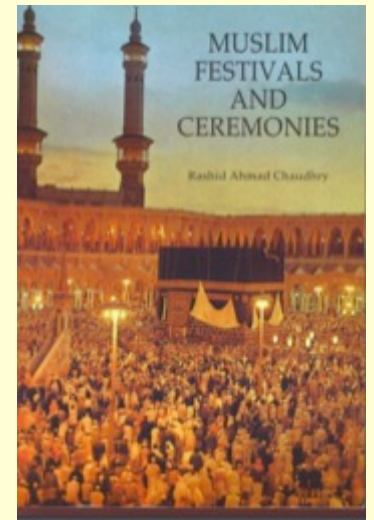


Muslim Festivals and Ceremonies

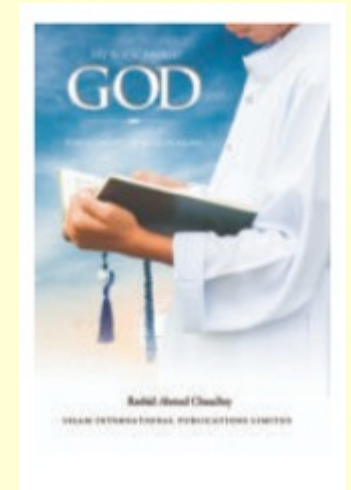
My Book About God **The Concept of God in Islam**

The booklet answers these and many more questions, set in an everyday home environment where children ask questions freely to their elders.

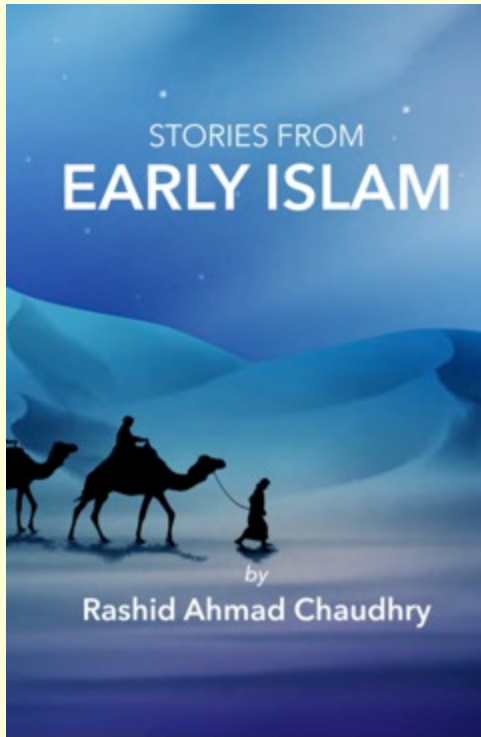


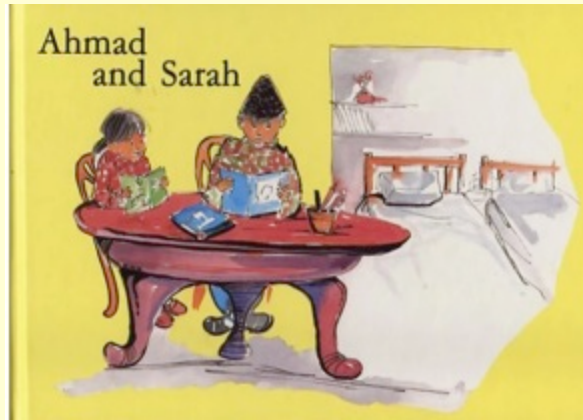
Stories from Early Islam

Stories From Early Islam is a collection of true stories about the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, and his companions, may Allah be pleased with them.

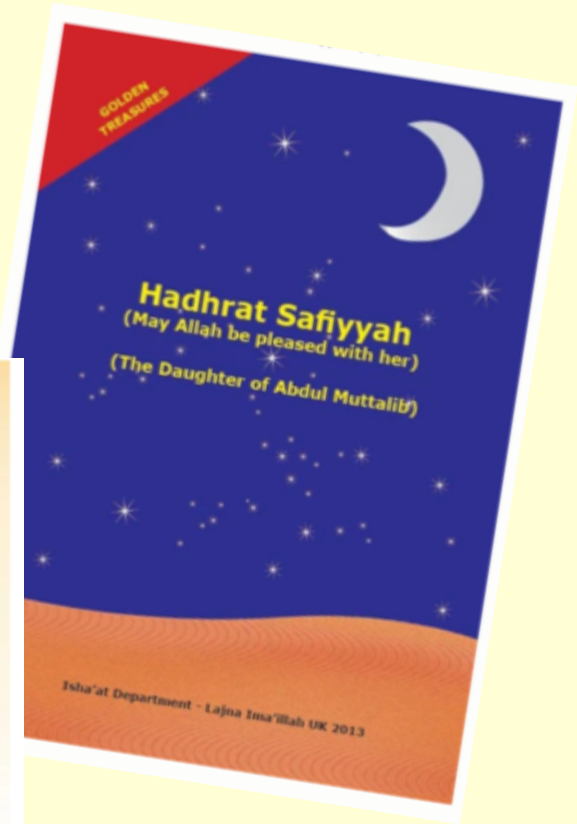
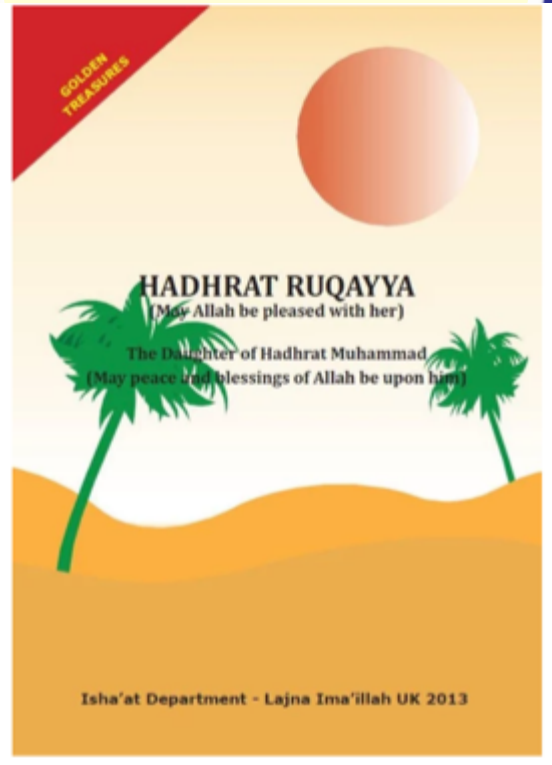
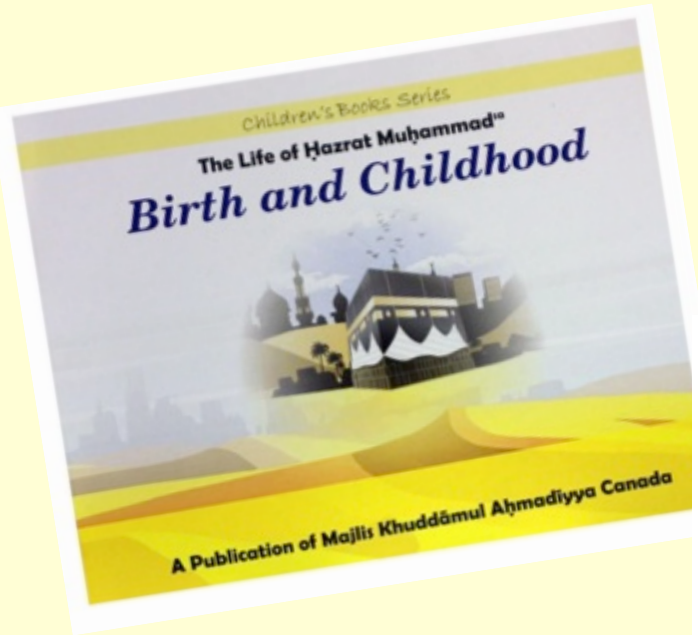
