






- Children have a huge capacity to understand if they know why they are learning something. Before you begin to teach them how to read the Holy Quran explain why they are learning to read it, if they are able to understand.
- Explain that it is important to Muslims because it is the word of Allah.
- Explain that it contains a complete guide to living our lives in the best possible way.

"The best among you is the one who learns the Qur'an and teaches it to others." (Bukhari)



The Holy Qur'an is the fundamental basis of Islam. Its teachings affect every aspect of our lives as Ahmadi Muslims. The Holy Qur'an speaks of the need for acceptance for special needs and the need for special provision for them.

Developments in education in the last few years have allowed for an array of new techniques for teaching these children. There has been significant development of our understanding of special needs. This guide has been written to assist and inspire parents and teachers on how to develop strategies to teach their students.

The Holy Quran should be taught in achievable steps. The long term objective should be broken down into much smaller goals or objectives.

For example:

- □ LONG TERM LEARNING OBJECTIVE: I WOULD LIKE TO LEARN TO READ THE HOLY QURAN
- □ SUCCESS CRITERIA: I WILL FINISH THE HOLY QURAN
- ☐ 1ST SHORT TERM LO: TO LEARN MY ALPHABET

Ideas for smaller objectives:

- Letter recognition and sounds
- Letter recognition in joined up form and sounds
- Fattha, Damma and Kasra sounds and recognition on each letter
- Vertical Fattha, Damma and Kasra long sounds and recognition on each letter
- Madda sound practice and recognition
- Fathatan, Dammatan and Kasratan sounds and recognition on each letter
- Sukoon recognition & no vowel and practice
- Shadda recognition of doubled stronger sound
- Devise simple reading tasks of words and sentences.






- Make Learning Fun and Positive.

- Brainstorm & Communicate ideas with parents and Students.




Lesson timetable or tick list activities



Visuals timetables/tick lists can be a useful learning aid for Taleem & Tarbiyyat of children and adults with S.E.N.D. Timetables help (what comes next in a series of activities) and 'executive functioning' (planning and organising).

In order to motivate learning it is important to create slow and steady building blocks of learning. We have provided some more examples of activities for the next stages of learning the Holy Quran.



Learning goal/objective: Recognising joined up Arabic Letters:

Letter formation with play dough, sand or moon sand fulfils the sensory need of 'touch' and keeps the concentration needed to learn.








