1. STUDY OF THE HOLY QURAN WITH COMMENTARY

- This month we will be studying Surah At Tatfif (Chapter 83) of the Holy Quran.
- This Surah opens with a severe condemnation of the use of false measures and weights for the purpose of defrauding others. It takes its title from the word **مطففين** which means "who give short measure." In this Surah stress has been laid on man's dealings with his fellow-beings, with special reference to the cruel exploitation by Christian powers of weaker and less developed nations after depriving them of their liberty of action. The Surah ends on a note of stern warning to the unjust and dishonest people that they will not be allowed to go unpunished. The Day of Reckoning awaits them in all its frightfulness and severity (Reference: <https://www.alislam.org/quran/app/83>)

- Explaining the meaning of the word ‘Salam’ in his Friday Sermon of 11th May 2007, Beloved Huzur (aba) said that it is that Being Whose creation is safe from His oppression. The word is used for Allah Almighty because it denotes that He is free from any flaw or defect and is also free from the calamities that befall others, all creation will perish but death cannot overtake Him. He is also called Salam because of His supreme bestowal of well-being and security.
- How can we emulate the attribute of As Salam in our lives? How does one go about becoming a source of peace for others? How does peace within ourselves help us spread peace within our homes, our communities and the world? Please reflect on the example of the life of the Holy Prophet (saw) who exemplified this attribute of Allah Almighty in every aspect of his life.
