1. STUDY OF THE HOLY QURAN WITH COMMENTARY

- This month we continue with the study of Surah At-Tatfif (Chapter 83) of the Holy Quran.

Please study verses 14-25 of Surah At-Tatfif with Commentary. As you study these verses, particularly verses 16-18, reflect on what they tell us about those who are granted the sight of God and the two stages through which this is achieved? Further, consider the meaning and significance of the word ‘Illiyin’ in verse 19 as detailed in the Commentary.

- In Surah Al Baqarah verse 153 Allah Almighty says,

فَاذْكُرُونِيْٓ اَذْكُرْكُمْ

“So Remember Me, and I will Remember you.”

- What are the means that we have been taught to remember Allah Almighty and how do we instil the habit of remembering Allah at all times, both during adversity and ease?
