Saturday 23rd March 1889 was the momentous day when Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad, the Promised Messiah^(a.s.), accepted the hands of forty faithful servants in allegiance to the [Ten Conditions of Bai'at](#) (initiation) and founded the community which he called '[The Ahmadiyya Muslim Community](#)'.
