Lajna Ima'illah UK will once again launch the annual Tehrik under the banner of **#VoicesForPeace** – **Humanitarian Appeal**.

This initiative is dedicated to supporting the vulnerable and helpless who have been affected by the ongoing crises in the Middle East. The appeal begins in October and will be promoted by Secretaries throughout the year. Four official posters have been provided by the National team; one should be circulated each week during October and then used across the year to maintain awareness.

Secretaries are encouraged to consistently remind members of the donation channels: the Lajna Chanda Portal or their local Finance Secretary. Every member should be motivated to contribute, with emphasis placed on the profound impact of even the smallest donations and on raising awareness.

'It is not righteousness that you turn your faces to the East or the West, but truly righteous is he who believes in Allah and the Last Day and the angels and the Book and the Prophets, and spends his money out of love for Him, on the kindred and the orphans and the needy and the wayfarer and those who ask for charity, and for ransoming the captives; and observes Prayer and pays the Zakat.... it is these who have proved truthful and it is these who are truly God-fearing'

Feeding the poor and assisting those in need is regarded as a highly virtuous and integral aspect of Islamic teachings. To attain the pleasure of Allah Almighty, significant emphasis is placed on charity and service to humanity. The monthly target – "Feeding the homeless" aims to uphold and fulfil these teachings.

Description: During the cold months of November and December 2025, Lajna will provide support to the homeless in their local community. Secretaries can locate nearby homeless charities by reaching out to local councils or conducting an online search.

Implementation: Secretaries are encouraged to thoughtfully prepare a plan of action and explore effective ways of supporting the local homeless shelters. It may be helpful to reach out to local charities that support the homeless, learn about their needs, and discover the most effective ways to offer assistance. The aim is to take initiative with kindness and gently remind our Lajna sisters of the importance of extending warmth and care to the homeless during this time.

Ideas to Support the Homeless

(Each majlis can pick one or more, or create new ideas based on local needs)

- **Donating warm clothes** As the weather gets colder, items such as jackets, jumpers, shoes, hats, and gloves can bring real comfort. Please ensure all clothing is clean, in good condition, and suitable for the season.
- Sharing basic essentials Hygiene products, bedding, blankets, sleeping bags, and long-lasting food items are always needed.
- Offering food donations Non-perishable items are especially helpful. Please check with local charities about any food safety rules.
- Cooking and serving meals Preparing meals for those in need or helping with community meal programmes.
- **Volunteering time** Many shelters and kitchens welcome volunteers. Giving your time and skills can be just as valuable as material support.
- **Supporting financially** Donations to local charities working with the homeless help them continue their important work.
