1. STUDY OF THE HOLY QURAN - TA'LIM WORKSHOP

This term we begin the study of *Surah Al-A'la* (Chapter 87) of the Holy Quran with commentary.

ACTIVITY: Please study verses 1-5 of this Surah this month.

Beloved Huzur (aba) has given a detailed commentary of the first four verses of the Surah in his Friday Sermon of 14 May 2010. As you study the commentary of these verses and re-listen to Beloved Huzur's Sermon, please reflect on the following points:

- 1. According to the commentary of verse 2, what do the words "رَبُّكَ الْاَ عُلَى " (The Most High Lord) signify?
- 2. How has Beloved Huzur (aba) explained the meaning of verse 3, 'Who creates and perfects'?
- 3. What four reasons are given in verses 3 and 4 for the glorification of God?
