#### How to complete this


- Plan for your workshop well in advance

- Embroidery (cross stitch, chain stitch).

- Choose based on what your lajna enjoys. Find someone to teach. Choose a task that needs to be completed by the end of the quarter.
- Prior to the start of the quarter, choose which of these you would like to do. Aim to have a completed by the end of the quarter.
