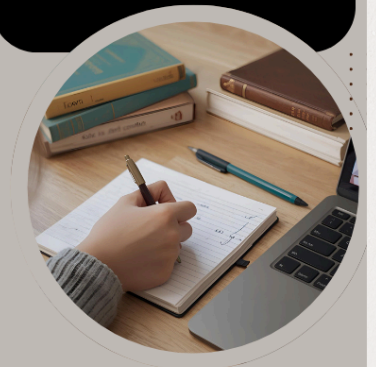

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## Spiritual Journey to Ahmadiyyat —Yasmin Ouaadil

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My first experience of Ahmadiyyat was a school trip to visit Baitul Futuh in Morden, I believe this was truly the start of my journey as it filled my mind with questions which weren't answered until much later. During sixth form and university I made friends from the Ahmadiyya Jamaat, furthering my curiosity and interest, we would have discussion, and I would ask them questions. Following this I started to dig deeper into the true meaning of Ahmadiyyat, doing my own research and reading. One by one the misconceptions I had been told growing up were being clarified and my doubts were fading. Meanwhile, I was praying and making dua that Allah will guide me to the right path. the consistency between what I was learning in Ahmadiyyat and what I had always prayed for—a faith rooted in peace, truth, and a living connection with Allah. The teachings of the Promised Messiah (as) resonated with me deeply, not as something foreign, but as the natural completion of what I already believed. I began to see that Ahmadiyyat was not a new path, but the revival of Islam in its purest form.

I would pray salaah Istikhara and felt my prayers for guidance were being answered, I could no longer ignore the pull in my heart.

Accepting Ahmadiyyat was not a sudden decision, but the result of reflection, prayer, and the gradual unfolding of truth. It has been the most important decision of my life and has brought me peace, a lifelong connection to the jamaat and a deeper love for my faith. Looking back my journey to Ahmadiyyat started the day I first walk into Baitul Futuh.
