3. What are the means to achieving true prosperity as stated in Verses 15 and 16 and how can we strive towards attaining this?

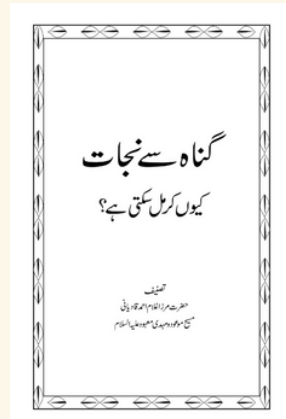
