


The Nau Mubai'at Classes consists of 5 subjects. Each subject will run for 8 weeks in which 7 or 8 topics will be covered. The classes will run once weekly, one topic per class/week.

The classes will run throughout the year starting in January with the first subject; the Holy Quran.

The fifth subject, History, will conclude at the end of December.

The classes will run every Monday from 6 pm-7 pm starting from Monday January 5<sup>th</sup> 2026.




