## **1. STUDY OF THE HOLY QUR'AN: (TA'LIM WORKSHOP)**

This month we continue the study of **Surah Al-A'la** (Chapter 87) of the Holy Qur'an with commentary.

**ACTIVITY:** As you study verses 17-20 of the Surah this month, reflect on the following questions:

- In verses 17-18, Allah Taala states 'But you prefer the life of this world, Whereas the Hereafter is better and more lasting.' Why, when knowing the rewards of the Hereafter are far greater, does man still prefer the life of this world? How can we remain focused on striving for the everlasting rewards of the Hereafter rather than the temporary gains of this world?
- What may verse 20 signify in regards to the prophecy that is found in the scriptures of both Abraham (as) and Moses (as)?

***“And hold fast, all together, by the rope of Allah”***

- What does this Commandment of the Holy Qur'an teach us about the importance of unity?

- What does the ‘rope’ in this Commandment of The Holy Qur’an represent, and what does it teach us about the means to strengthen our connection with Allah Taala?

In the same verse, Allah Taala states:

***“And remember the favour of Allah which He bestowed upon you”***

- What ‘favour’ is this Commandment of the Holy Qur’an referring to?
- In your Ta’lim workshop, reflect on the personal, social and spiritual rewards of appreciating Allah Taala’s favour on us.

By God! (The Holy Prophet) Muhammad<sup>saw</sup> is certainly like the Prime Minister (in his spiritual relation to Almighty God)

Some discussion points are listed below:

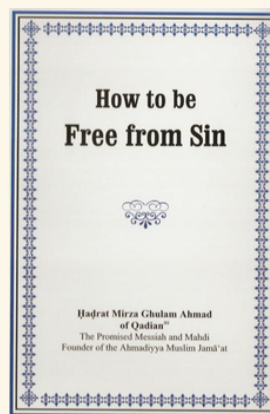
- What are the opposing forces of good and evil?
