3. PRAYER TO MEMORISE – (TALEEM WORKSHOP) SURAH AL-BAQARAH, CHAPTER 2, VERSE 287

Members should memorise the following Prayer with its translation from verse 287 of Surah Al Baqarah. It is a beautiful prayer seeking Allah’s Mercy and Forgiveness, which is a central focus in the month of Ramadan.

رَبَّنَا لَا تُؤَاخِذْنَا إِنْ نَسِينَا أَوْ أَخْطَأْنَا ۗ رَبَّنَا وَلَا تَحْمِلْ عَلَيْنَا إصْرًا كَمَا حَمَلْتَهُ عَلَى الَّذِينَ مِنْ قَبْلِنَا ۗ رَبَّنَا وَلَا تُحَمِّلْنَا مَا لَا طَاقَةَ لَنَا بِهِ ۗ وَاعْفُ عَنَّا ۗ وَارْحَمْنَا ۗ أَنْتَ مَوْلَانَا فَانصُرْنَا عَلَى الْقَوْمِ الْكَافِرِينَ ﴿٢٨٧﴾

Translation: Our Lord, do not punish us, if we forget or fall into error; and our Lord, lay not on us a responsibility as Thou didst lay upon those before us. Our Lord, burden us not with what we have not the strength to bear; and efface our *sins*, and grant us forgiveness and have mercy on us; Thou art our Master; so help us Thou against the disbelieving people.

4. MALFUZAT (SELF-STUDY) “DIVINE DECREE”

The Promised Messiah (as) explains that there are two kinds of decree: one may be referred to as suspended (mu'allaq) and the other is known as absolute (mubram). The operation of a suspended decree may be prevented by the Grace of Allah Almighty through prayer and almsgiving. An absolute decree, however, cannot be altered or prevented through prayer and almsgiving.

(BOOK CLUB)**


In pages 18-21 the Promised Messiah (as) discusses the Christian belief of Hazrat Isa’s (as) Crucifixion and the concept of Salvation.

ACTIVITY:


- Discuss the Christian viewpoint on the Crucifixion and why it is opposite to our own beliefs.
