## 1. STUDY OF THE HOLY QUR'AN (GENERAL MEETING)

We continue the study of Surah Al-Ghashiyah (Chapter 88) this month, focusing on verses 9-13.

**ACTIVITY:** As you study these verses with their commentary, consider the following questions:

- According to the commentary of verses 9-10, what qualities or actions in this life lead to a person having a *'joyful'* face on the Day of Judgment?
- In verse 12, why is the absence of vain talk mentioned as a blessing of Paradise?
- What does the imagery of a *'running spring'* mentioned in verse 13 symbolise, and how does this verse connect to the idea of spiritual nourishment?

## 2. COMMANDMENT OF THE HOLY QURAN (SELF STUDY)

Let us reflect on the Commandment mentioned in the Holy Quran, "And ask Allah of His bounty" (Surah An-Nisa, verse 33).

In this verse Allah Taala Commands us to rely on Him and ask Him alone for all that we desire, rather than of wishing for or envying what others have. The Commandment reminds us that Allah Taala's bounty is limitless and that we are reminded to turn to Him for all our needs. Therefore, by acting on this Commandment of the Holy Quran, we are taught to turn to Allah Taala directly, avoid comparison and cultivate contentment.

**ACTIVITY:**

- How can we ensure that we practice this Commandment in our daily lives?

### 3. ATTRIBUTE OF ALLAH TAALA (GENERAL MEETING)

This month, we will focus on studying Allah Taala's attribute of '*Al Aziz*' (*The Mighty*).

Beloved Huzur (aba) explained in his Friday Sermon of 19 Oct 2007, that Al Aziz means The Strong Who overcomes everything, and The Unattainable Who no one can overcome.

**ACTIVITY:** As you re-listen to Beloved Huzur's (aba) Friday Sermons referenced below, explaining the attribute of Al Aziz, consider the following points in your discussion:

- How can we strengthen our Trust in Allah Taala as Al Aziz when facing trials or tribulations?
- How does understanding this Attribute of Allah Taala help us to recognise that worldly power is temporary and limited?
- What do we learn about this Attribute through the writings of the Promised Messiah (as) as explained by Beloved Huzur (aba) in his Sermons?

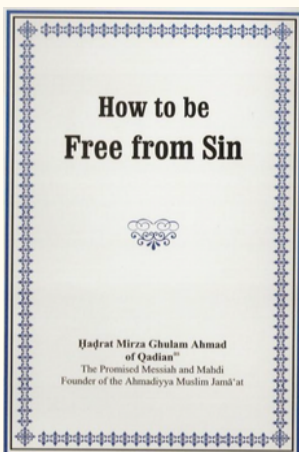
**5. BOOK OF THE YEAR – ‘HOW TO BE FREE FROM
